<b>Indigenous Programming (Beading)</b>	Come join us for this program that teaches you how to bead and mingle with other parents! Lunch is provided.
<b>Indigenous Programming (Family Drumming)</b>	This program is held in the gym we bring in traditional a drum group and woman hand drummers. This is a perfect program to come practice traditional dancing and learn to drum.
<b>Little Leonardo</b>	Little Leonardo is an art program that provides opportunities for the children and their families to create process art or open-ended art together. We offer a large variety of art supplies to nurture your children's passion for art.
<b>Outdoor Play</b>	All children benefit from time spent outside playing and exploring where they are able to connect with the natural world and their community. Opportunities for gross motor and highly active play are often easier to offer in outdoor play spaces. The outdoor play will be in the Daycare Play yard. Weather permitting.
<b>Play Learn &amp; Drop In</b>	This program is an opportunity to follow your children's interest while simultaneously working on the four foundations from How Does Learning Happen. The children will have many opportunities to decide their play experience and use a variety of different quality materials whether it be indoors or outdoors. Play is very important to a child's overall development. Play allows the children to develop skills in the five domains; Cognitive, Social, Emotional, Language and Physical Development.
<b>Mommy &amp; Me Cooking</b>	This 3 hour class will give both parents and their children the opportunity to get messy in the kitchen. Participants will be able to learn new skills in the kitchen and bond through sitting down and eating the food that they made together

<b>Indigenous Programming (Sewing Circle)</b>	<p>Our sewing program is a great opportunity for you to come make ribbon skirts or anything you would like to sew. We have all the materials you will need to make a project!</p>
<b>Making The Connections</b>	<p>This is a 8 week activity-based program that helps parents to foster a secure, nurturing relationship with their baby. Each session incorporates hands-on parent-baby activities, reflections and discussions to help parents reflect on key components of secure attachment. This secure beginning sets in motion a positive course for a child's social and emotional well-being, learning in school and contribution to society.</p>
<b>1000 Books Event Storytelling/Reading In TeePee</b>	<p>Come join us in the teepee for story telling and reading! We will be in the teepee outside so be sure to dress accordingly, we will also have a fire and a lunch!</p>
