In light of Ontario's state of emergency and stay-at-home orders, Timmins Native Friendship Centre will be limiting access to our building. However, the TNFC will continue to provide essential services during this time. Some staff will be primarily working from home - core staff will remain on site - and all staff will be available via telephone, email, and social media pages. The receptionist will also be available to direct communication as necessary to ensure client needs are met.

Clients are encouraged to book appointments with their worker in advance to ensure adherence to physical distancing measures. Drop-ins will continue to be welcomed for immediate assistance. Any persons entering our building must follow our COVID-19 policies and procedures.

At this time, the Oppekehawaso Wekamik will remain open; however, may be subject to change with little notice. Our Child Care Centre is committed to ensuring the overall safety and wellbeing of your child(ren) and our staff. All persons entering the Oppekehawaso Wekamik will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms and a COVID-19 Response Plan has been put into place to protect the health and safety of all in the Centre.

We will continue to offer Grab-and-Go Community Kitchen on Tuesdays and Socials on Wednesdays. Snack bags and essential services will continue to be offered at the door.

We are committed to serving our community and will provide updates as they become available. Please continue to follow public health guidelines to keep our community safe.
